Notes for using PARTNER Data from Wave 2 County Coalition Surveys

**Step 1**: This survey used the PARTNER survey and related services of VNL. Begin with understanding the survey. Survey instrument is included as one of the files within the archived data. The surveys were completed twice (at start of HCS implementation July of 2022 and end of implementation (January 2024—noted as POST). Survey response high at start, ranging from 51% to 91%; response rate low at end (50% or below, with most below 30%).

Step 2: In understanding the data available, review and understand the sequence of questions in the survey instrument. Survey contains a series of questions about organizational factors (i.e., resources that that organization brings to the coalition, success rating for coalition) and noted as non-relational data. The second series of questions ask organizational members to "rate" their peers in the coalition that they have some relation with—noted as relational data. Data for each county in included in the data and noted as: county\_nrd or county\_RD. There is a third file for each county (countyIS) that includes variables as calculated as part of the PARTNER program providing summary level scores for each agency on value and trust measures, degree centrality and in-degree and out-degree centrality.

The HCS county teams determined and assigned a sector designation for each of the agencies. This cross walk is included in file: **Couty sector identification**
